- 6) Patty Hug reported on Status of Stetson Ranch Equestrian Center, listing new additions and improvements, sprinklers, driving arena, dressage arena and trail course area. There is \$100,000 left in Stetson Ranch Quimby funds.
- 7) There is \$200,000 in Park and Recreation which has been allotted for trails from collection of Equine License. LA Animal services reports 1371 licensed horses in the City of Los Angeles. Sylmar Zip code has the most horses licensed. Pam brought up discount on Equine license and will report on exactly what it will exactly be at next meeting. County Vector Control is assigning fees for 10 horses or more kept in one location. LA County is charging fees for an animal keeper's license and boarder fees. Get word out to the community about abandoned horse at Stetson Ranch. Suggestion to write a letter to City Supervisor regarding the water being turned off at Bucher Street.
- 8) Connector trail from Stetson Ranch, a letter will be written to manager of Oak Ridge Mobile Home Park regarding repairs to the trail entrance to keep off roaders off the horse/pedestrian trail. Trail entrance has been in disrepair since Sylmar fire when emergency vehicles entered the area. Discussion to have a work party day to install chain link fence at the trail entrance. Pam may have a chain link donation.
